Statement on California Proposition 65

Under the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (known as Proposition 65 or "Prop 65"), the State of California creates and updates annually a list of chemicals known by the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity ("Prop 65 List").

The purpose of the Proposition 65 warning is to ensure that people are informed about exposure to such chemicals by the State of California.

Based on the foregoing information, Marposs S.p.A. has determined to the best of its knowledge and belief that certain Marposs S.p.A. products may contain one or more of the chemicals on the Prop 65 List. Marposs S.p.A. products are not intended to cause the user exposure to any contained substances, nor are they intended to be released or discharged during normal product use.

To our knowledge, Marposs S.p.A. products are within the "no significant risk" range, and not harmful when normally used.

If after review of available material content information and our products we determine an exposure requiring a Prop 65 warning may exist, Marposs S.p.A. will provide the necessary "clear and reasonable" warning.
